Charles has been a farmer for more than 20 years, and has worked with One Acre Fund for a while now, having joined for the first time in 2011, because he wanted to have access to quality training and acquire new farming methods. Not only will he get maize seeds and fertilizer with his loan, but also a solar light in order to reduce the consumption of paraffin fuel and therefore save more money. He decided that he will use the profits he gains from this year's harvest to send his children to school.
